**Prague**, the capital of the **Czech Republic**, has been an important centre of culture and learning for over a thousand years. Its first university was established as early as 1348. It was the first university of its kind in central Europe. Famous European scholars of the late Renaissance, such as astronomers **Tycho Brahe** and **Johannes Keppler**, lived and worked in Prague. Throughout the 17<sup>th</sup>, 18<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup> centuries, many world renowned scholars and scientists held chairs at **Prague's Charles University**. In the late 19<sup>th</sup> and early 20<sup>th</sup> century, **Ernst Mach** and **Albert Einstein** held chairs at the **Department of Theoretical** 

**Physics** at the German University of Prague. French, German and particularly Italian architects, sculptors and garden designers, have given Prague a unique cosmopolitan flair. **The Old Town, Charles Bridge**, the **Small Quarter, Prague Castle**, and masterpieces of late Gothic, Renaissance and Baroque architecture have been carefully maintained and protected by successive generations of rulers and monarchs, keeping the historical centre of Prague virtually untouched and perfectly preserved. **UNESCO** has listed Prague's historical centre as one of the cultural heritages of mankind. Apart from being an attractive tourist destination and centre of arts and culture, Prague is also a prominent centre for higher education - at a crossroad between East, West, North and South, it is the ideal destination for anyone who wishes to be part of a truly global experience.

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

CULS Prague has launched the **Erasmus Without Paper Initiative**. Therefore, incoming Erasmus+ exchange students do not submit any paper or online application form for study at CULS Prague.

First, a student must be nominated by their sending institution (student's home institution).

After their nomination and acceptance, the respective Incoming Erasmus Coordinator will create the student's profile in the CULS University Information System (UIS). The student will then receive their username and password **by email**. After logging in to UIS, it is imperative that students upload their photo and fill in missing details regarding their address and passport/national ID number. We will then ask students to submit the following in UIS:

- Transcript of Records (overview of your study results/grades)
- Health Insurance Card (European blue card or commercial travel insurance)
- Language Certificate if it is applicable

#### LEARNING AGREEMENT

At CULS, we fully endorse the Erasmus Without Paper Initiative, supported by the European Commission. For that reason, we only accept submissions by an **Online Learning Agreement** (OLA).

Incoming students are allowed to choose and mix courses from all faculties; incoming bachelor's degree students may also enroll in master's level courses.

# ACCOMMODATION AT HALLS OF RESIDENCE

In order to secure the transparent and equal treatment of all applicants, we publish the application form's availability in the second half of June.

We have **3 rounds** of application. Each round accommodates students in the following situations:



#### FIRST ROUND

- Students who require a visa for study, as a confirmation of accommodation is a legal requirement in the visa process.
- Students who were awarded the Top-Up Erasmus Grant for students from disadvanted socio-economic environments (for details, as the Erasmus coordinator at your home university)
- Students from the following income groups set by the World Bank: low, lower middle and upper middle income.

#### **SECOND ROUND**

 Students from Group 3, according to the Erasmus+ Programme Guide 2019, page No.45: Bulgaria, Croatia, Estonia, Latvia, Lithuania, Hungary, Poland, Romania, Slovakia, Slovenia, FYROM North Macedonia, and Turkey.

#### THIRD ROUND

• The remaining spaces will be offered to all students on a "first come, first served" basis.

#### The conditions for accommodation in CULS dormitories:

CULS Halls of Residence offer accommodation only in the form of two, twin-bedded, shared rooms. Monthly rent is approximately **3 500 CZK** and residents are obliged to pay a **5 000 CZK** deposit. Rooms are equiped with a fridge and hot plate, pillows, duvets and bed sheets.

# HALLS OF RESIDENCE



Halls of Residence are located on campus and are well-equiped. Each room is equipped with basic amenities, i.e. writing desks and cupboards, reading lamps and cleaning equipment (broom, bucket etc.). Laundry rooms are situated on the ground floor of each residence hall. You can ask for the washing machine room key at the reception desk in each residence hall. The costs for using the washing machine will be deducted from your electronic wallet (see ISIC below).

Accommodation costs: **3 500 CZK** approximately **140 EUR** and includes bed, pillow, blanket, sheets (see Laundry Service below), heating, warm and cold water, local taxes and insurance. Students may pay extra for internet connection (**162 CZK** (aprox. **8 EUR**) per month). Do not forget to bring your Ethernet Cable with you.

Most of incoming Erasmus students are accommodated at the EFG and JIH Halls of Residence. Rooms in the EFG and JIH have two beds. Bathrooms are always shared between two rooms.

# **WELCOME WEEK**

**Welcome Week** is organised one week prior to the start of each semester and is compulsory for **incoming Erasmus+ students** and international exchange students from non-EU countries. # ARRIVAL INFORMATION

#### **HOW TO GET TO CULS**

Our Campus is located in the Suchdol city district in northern Prague. First, you need to get to the metro station, **Dejvická**. From there you can take the bus No. 107 or 147 and get off at the bus stop, Zemědělská Univerzita.

#### **COMING BY PLANE**

Prague's Vaclav Havel Airport is located 15 km west of the city centre. If you would prefer to use public transportation instead of a taxi service, getting to CULS is an easy bus+metro ride. Below are the steps to reaching campus from the airport:

Take bus no. 119 (the bus line is available from both Terminal 1 and Terminal 2) to the Metro Line A (Green) station, Nádraží Veleslavín

Note: each stop is announced on the public address system in the bus and metro.

- Take the metro in direction of **Skalka/Depo Hostivař**, and get off at the **Dejvická** station.
- From **Dejvická**, take bus no. **107** or **147** and get off at the **Zemědělská Univerzita** stop.

#### **COMING BY TRAIN**

There are two central train stations in Prague: Hlavní nádraží or Holešovice. Below are the steps to reaching campus from the train station:

- 1. Take the Metro Line C (Red) and get off at the **Muzeum** stop.
- Transfer to the Metro Line A in the direction towards Motol and get off at Deivická. To transfer, simply follow the arrows pointing in the direction of Metro Line A.
- From **Dejvická**, take bus no. 107 or 147 to the bus stop **Zemědělská Univerzita**. 3.

#### **COMING BY INTERNATIONAL BUS**

International bus passengers arrive at the Bus Terminal, Florenc. This bus terminal is location on the Metro line C. Below are the steps to reaching campus from the bus station:

- 1. Take the **Metro line C** and get off at the **Muzeum stop**.
- Transfer to the Metro Line A in the direction towards Motol and get off at the Dejvická stop.
- 3. From **Dejvická**, take bus no. **107** or **147** and get off at **Zemědělská Univerzita**.

# AFTER YOUR ARRIVAL AT CAMPUS

#### **CHECK IN AT CULS HALLS OF RESIDENCE**

All residents must sign an accommodation contract with their respective Hall of Residence

#### **MANAGER**

Ms. Monika Kurková (JIH Hall of Residence) Mr. Pavel Řeřábek (EFG Hall of Residence).



Students are kindly requested to arrive only during official workdays (Monday-Friday from 08:00 to 15:00) in order to register and pay for accommodation. For this signature, students will need a valid passport (for EU citizens, an ID card is sufficient). For more information, please ask reception for the location of the respective manager's office.

Payment for accommodation can be made at the CULS Central Cash Desk, situated on the ground floor of the **Study and Information Centre** (SIC).

The accommodation fee has to be paid by the 15th of each month. After your arrival, you will be prompted for the deposit – **5 000 CZK**.



#### **DURING YOUR STUDY STAY - CHANGES IN YOUR LEARNING AGREEMENT**

If there is a time overlap with your courses, or if a course does not meet your expectations, you are allowed to make a change in your schedule **within the first two weeks of the respective semester**. Changes requested after this deadline will not be considered. Changes are made via Online Learning Agreement.

#### IS.CZU.CZ - UNIVERSITY INFORMATION SYSTEM (UIS)

CARNET INTERNACIONAL DE PROFESOR

UIS is the most important webpage for your future study at CULS. On this page, you can see your timetable, grades, exam applications, etc. Your login and password information will be sent to you prior to your arrival. If you fill in your bank account number, you may receive a housing scholarship (the application is available in your UIS account).

#### **ISIC CARD**

The ISIC card is a student card which can be used for entering university facilities. It also serves as a transportation card, university electronic wallet (note: only on the CULS campus), and restaurant discount card for restaurants outside of the university.



The card is issued by **Study Information Center** (SIC) and it costs **280 CZK**.

The **University Electronic Wallet** (UEP) account allows you to pay in the canteen and coffee/snack machines while using your ISIC card. To open a UEP, you must pay a **300 CZK** refundable deposit. The ISIC card then becomes active in 24 hours.

#### **PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION CARD AND FARES**

- Your valid ISIC card.
- Alternative public transportation card

We recommend that you use your ISIC card as your public transportation card. It is easy and you can top up your ISIC directly in Menza – ČZU shop.



If you do not want to use your **ISIC** as your public transportation card, you need to have an approved special document (Application for Transportation Card) which you can receive at the Erasmus office. You will also need a passport-sized photo. It is possible to obtain this alternative public transportation card from Prague's Public Transport Company (Czech translation: DPP) located at almost all metro stations. The nearest transport company is at the station, Dejvická.

#### **UNIVERSITY CASH DESK**

All payments for accommodation, safety deposit, etc. are paid in cash or debit (VISA or Mastercard) at the university cash desk, situated on the ground floor of the Study and Information Centre (SIC). The CULS ISIC Card and ISIC insurance fees can only be paid in cash at the university cash desk (SIC).

#### REGISTERING WITH FOREIGN POLICE

Non-EU citizens, accommodated at CULS Halls of Residence, will be automatically registered with the foreign police by the CULS Halls of Residence management office.

#### **STUDY**

Each academic year is divided into two semesters.

- Winter
- Summer

The duration for one semester is 12 weeks. Each semester is divided into a:

- 12 week course period, during which students attend 5 6 different course units
- 3–5-week examination period

#### **BANK ACCOUNT**

To open a bank account, you will need two identification documents – **passport** + **ID** or driving license – your **ISIC** card and a **Confirmation of Study letter**.

\*You can obtain a Confirmation of Study from the International Office in the Rectorate building.

In the Czech Republic, there are plenty of available banks. If you want to have access to an ATM close to the university, we strongly recommend **Komerční banka** or **Česká Spořitelna**.

#### HOUSING SCHOLARSHIP

#### Only for students who have already arrived at CULS Prague

If you want to receive a housing scholarship, you will need a **Czech bank account**. To open an account, you will need a **Confirmation of Study letter**. You will be provided this document at registration. If you happen to misplace your document, you can ask for a new one at the International Relations Office during office hours.

When you have your **Czech bank account**, go to: **is.czu.cz**, log in, click on student's portal, click on Bank accounts and add your account number.

Then, fill in the application for the housing scholarship. The process for this application is the following: go to is.czu.cz, click on Student's portal, click on Accommodation benefit application form and fill it in. The result has to be an active request.

#### **HEALTH INSURANCE**

#### **EU Citizens Health Insurance**

Legal regulations concerning medical care for EU students involved in mobility programmes, such as ERASMUS, CEEPUS etc. stipulate that incoming students have free access to any necessary health care during their study/research periods in the Czech Republic.

Incoming students who are EU citizens are entitled to the same healthcare as Czech citizens.

Prior to Treatment: Students who are EU citizens must present their EU insurance card (EHIC) and a Certificate of Insurance delivered by the Czech General Health Insurance Company (Všeobecná Zdravotní Pojišťovna aka VZP) This certificate is provided free of charge at any VZP branch office. If you do not have this certificate, you may have to pay a fee for each doctor visit (starting at **600 CZK**).

#### Non EU Citizens Health Insurance

Students from non EU countries must have a supplementary travel health insurance, covering the entire period of their stay in the **Czech Republic** before applying for their visa. They also must obtain the above-mentioned **Certificate of Insurance** from the Czech General Health Insurance Company **(Všeobecná zdravotní pojišťovna**).

Students from non EU countries staying in the Czech Republic longer than 3 months – i.e. a semester or an academic year – must have a contract with an insurance company in the Czech Republic or with an insurance company authorised by the Czech Embassy in their country of origin.



Please consult with your CULS coordinator at CULS before you apply for a long term visa. A Czech visa will not be delivered if insurance is not recognised by the Czech Embassy.

# HOW TO CONCLUDE THE STUDY STAY

In order to finish your study stay at CULS, you need to fulfill the following conditions:

- You are obliged to confirm course results in your UIS student account once all grades have been uploaded. The deadline for this confirmation is approximately one week prior to your departure from CULS. An exception is made for those who have exams scheduled after this date. If the grade has not been uploaded, you are required to contact your teachers by yourself and notify the CULS faculty coordinator by e-mail.
- Fill in the third part of your Learning Agreement After the Mobility. The
  document must be filled and printed out with correct arrival and departure
  dates. The CULS coordinator will stamp it and sign it THREE DAYS prior
  to your departure. The document can be downloaded via the following
  QR code:



If the sending (home) university requires its own duration of stay confirmation document, the respective student is required to fill in and bring a hard copy to CULS coordinator's office.




