


Why Hungary?











Increasing Number of Students

Your undergraduate degree is not related to the field you would like to study

You do not have the required number of credits – at least 30 credits – to start your studies on MA level.

Pre-Master's entry requirements:

Undergraduate degree
Academic transcript of records
English level equivalent to IELTS 6.0

Coventry University Programs

Top-up Program

Requirements:

120 business credits and BA degree or 4 closed semesters

(If 120 credit points were not gained in English language, IELTS 6.5 result is needed or an in-House language exam has to be taken in Budapest.)

Students with HND degree are welcome

Fees:

2950/semester = EUR 5900 in total

Coventry University Programs

Get two degrees:

Coventry+ METU degree (7 semesters)

Admission requirement: 168166 (V Semesters)

- secondary school certificate
- transcript of records

Fees:

- Coventry tuition fee: 1500 EUR/ semester (paid only in the 5th and 6th semesters: altogether 3000 EUR) +
- METU tuition fee: paid in each semester

Application Procedure

Two intakes: in February and in September

1. **Uploading** documents into the application system:

https://apply.metropolitan.hu/

2. Skype interview

Its aim is to learn more about your motivation, previous studies and future plans.

We assess if English language skills are sufficient for study purposes.

3. We issue the Conditional Acceptance Letter

which means the student can pay the tuition fees of the first two semesters and the Visa Assistance Package.

4. We issue the Final Letter of Admission

It is one of the most important documents for the applicants to apply for the student visa. We send it both by email and by courier mail.

The whole procedure takes 5-7 days.

Visa Assistance Package (220€)

- Includes Health Insurance (120€)
- Full legal assistance to advance a successful visa interview

VISA rejection non-refundable fees

- 95 € Application Fee
- 100€ Visa Assistance Fee
- 200€ administration fee

The University offers a 10% 'Early Bird' discount for those who transfer the app fee before the Early Bird deadline

September intake: 30th June for EU, 30th May for Non-EU students

February intake: 15th October for EU, 15th November for Non-EU students


Accommodation 1: Visit Hostel

Accommodation in twin rooms

All the campuses can be reached within 30 minutes, shopping malls and restaurants nearby

Rental fee: 200 € / person / month Deposit of 400 € to be transferred to reserve a place







Accommodation 2: Nova Inn Apartment House

In bedroom with 3 beds: 190 € /person/month In bedroom with 2 beds: 250 € /person/month In bedroom with 1 beds: 290 € /person/month balcony surcharge: 10 euros, until available

compulsory starter package, containing beddings, cutlery, towels: 100 € /person located less than 100 meters from the Nagy Lajos campus
