QUALITY OF EDUCATION

With a shared history of over 200 years, Malta's education system has and is still heavily influenced by the British academic system

The NCUK IFY (International Foundation Year) qualification has been benchmarked by NARIC - the National Recognition Information Centre for the United Kingdom. This organisation assesses a wide range of programmes and equates them to standard UK qualifications. NARIC concluded that the International Foundation Year qualification offers outcomes that are comparable to GCE A Level. This also makes this qualification recognised throughout all European countries.

All our lecturers are experienced and hold Master degrees in their chosen subjects, these qualifications have also been approved and verified by NCUK.

AFFORDABILITY

Before moving abroad to study you need to consider the tuition fees, accommodation and general cost of living. When compared to other English-speaking destinations in Europe such as the UK and Ireland, Malta is much more affordable.

Teaching takes place in a campus-like location which includes the classes, accommodation and supporting facilities. This eliminates the extra cost for travel, as well as saves the time and hassle of commuting.

Pre-sessional Programme

The Pre-sessional English courses are intensive and academically challenging courses intended for international students who are planning to study for an undergraduate or postgraduate degree at an English-speaking university, but do not meet the English language entry requirements.

The course is designed to help you meet the English language entry requirements of your degree course and to prepare you for the academic skills needed at an English-speaking university.

During the course you will:

- Improve your Academic English and become more confident in your use of the language
- Develop your skills in understanding and analysing academic texts
- Help you more fully understand lectures while taking effective notes
- Develop your ability to select, use and reference appropriate academic sources
- Develop your ability to write relevant, well-argued essays in an academic style
- Develop your critical thinking skills
- Build a degree of independence in the planning and organisation of your studies

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

You must have a minimum of IELTS 4.0 (with no less than 4.0 in any skill) for entry onto a Pre-sessional course - the equivalent in any other secure English language test (SELT) will be accepted as proof of English language proficiency.

LENGTH OF COURSE

The length of Pre-sessional English course you apply for depends on your current level of English. If you have a score higher than 4.0 you may be able to do a shorter course as outlined in the tables. The length of the course is also dependant on the English language level (both overall and for specific skills) required for entry onto your chosen future degree course. Furthermore, it is important to note that your individual progress will depend on numerous factors such as the intensity of the programme being followed; your aptitude and motivation; lesson attendance and the completion of homework, tests and assignments.

ENGLISH FOR ACADEMIC PURPOSES

- develop vocabulary most relevant to your course of study
- train you in specific skills such as listening to lectures, note-taking, making oral presentations, academic reading and writing

PHYSICS

The overall aim of this module is to provide you with a better understanding of the basic concepts and principles of physics. You will gain the required foundation knowledge to feel confident to start studying a Physics-related course at an undergraduate level. Syllabus includes:

CHEMISTRY

Your Journey to University

Before coming to the European College of Malta

A. High-school entry requirements for the International Foundation Year Qualification

Students must normally have successfully completed 12 years of school education. Students with only 11 years of education will be considered NSE (non-standard entry). B. English Language entry requirements for the International Foundation Year Qualification

Participants must meet the minimum English Language requirements to join the International Foundation Year programme. The following scores will help applicants determine if their qualifications match NCUK's requirements:

- Password 5.0 (this test can be facilitated by the European College of Malta at the agent's office)
- IELTS minimum 5.0 in each module (does not need to be UKVI IELTS)
- TOEFL 62
- PTE academic 46

At the European College of Malta

- NCUK International Foundation Year Qualification
- 6/8 month course at the European College of Malta with guaranteed progression to one of 16 leading UK universities upon successful completion of the course.
- The NCUK International Foundation Year programme is also a qualification recognised throughout Europe.
